Reflection

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the "Body of Christ". It is a solemnity which was first initiated by Jesus at the Last Supper, the night before He died. What took place that night was so important that a separate day, away from the events of Holy Week, is set aside by the Church to commemorate God's special gift to us. The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the Eucharist as the "source and summit of Christian life", and so it is. Whenever we receive Holy Communion, we do so in the knowledge that Jesus is with us once more, in His body and blood, through the gifts of bread and wine. Soul of Christ, sanctify me. Body of Christ, save me. Blood of Christ, inebriate me. Water from the side of Christ, wash me. Passion of Christ, strengthen me. O good Jesus, hear me. Within your wounds, hide me. Let me never be separated from you. From the malignant enemy, defend me. In the hour of my death, call me, and bid me come to you, that with your saints I may praise you forever and ever. Amen. ("Anima Christi" prayer, attributed to St Ignatius of Loyola 1491-1556).
