

Reflection

Whenever something goes wrong, there is a tendency to blame somebody else for the predicament that we find ourselves in: "it wasn't my fault"; "he / she made me do it", is often heard whenever the situation arises. In the First Reading from Genesis (3:9-15"), we hear once again about the "fall out" from Grace that Adam and Eve suffered. Adam blamed Eve for his mistakes. Eve blamed the Serpent. Whatever the rights and wrongs, mistakes were made, both turned away from God's grace and God's command. And although temptation, in the form of the snake in the Genesis story, exists today as it did then, none of us should ever be afraid or lack the resolution to own up to our mistakes whenever they are made. We all make them. Admitting our mistakes can sometimes make us vulnerable and isolated. But there is hope.

In today's Gospel, Jesus faced misunderstanding and rejection amongst the religious leaders of His time and even amongst those closest to Him. But with Him, we can have confidence to turn to God and the new 'family' that Jesus established of believers in faith. Pointing us towards God, Jesus provides us all with the blessing of His family and is the path to true acceptance and strength in our human weakness.
