Reflection

The invitation of Jesus in today's Gospel is clear: "have faith in me and do not let your hearts be troubled."

Fear is the opposite of faith. As Jesus said today to His apostles: "*Why are you so frightened? How is it that you have no faith?*" (*Mark 4:40*).

It is not God's will that we be blighted by fears of one kind or another. Today reminds us that God will always be there to help each and every one of us whenever we are in need, so long as we put our trust God's way.

In the words from the song: "Put your hand in the hand of the man who stills the waters, put your hand in the hand of the man who calms the sea. Take a look at yourself and you can look at others differently. Put your hand in the hand of the man from Galilee."


