

## Can you help please! (CTK Property)

We've reviewed the state of our buildings in Thornbury – the Church, Porch House and the Presbytery – and there are several remedial and general maintenance tasks that we need to deal with. Some are relatively straightforward – such as some general painting – whilst others are more challenging – repairing the Porch House roof, for example.

To help keep costs down and reduce the overall time that the jobs will take, we've identified two tasks that we're hoping some parishioners will be able to help with.

There are various external doors around our buildings that need a refresh – cleaning, rubbing down and a fresh coat of paint. We're planning on identifying a weekend with good weather and hoping that a few parishioners will be able to offer a few hours to help with the work.

The other job is rather more demanding. The boundary wall around the Church/Porch House needs some careful attention and we've been fortunate to have identified a stonemason craftsman who has agreed to take on the task of repairing the walls. We need to remove the loose mortar and cement around some of the stonework so that the stonemason can concentrate on the work of making good the walls. The stonemason is hoping to start work around August and so we have a few weeks to remove the loose fillings.

With both jobs we'll provide all the necessary tools and materials. Graham Hunter will be managing both tasks and he'd very much like to hear from any parishioners who would be able to help in any way with either of these jobs.
