

'You also must be ready'



Reflection: Be ready – at any time. In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus places His Disciples, and through them to us, "on their guard" for God's coming at any time. Something perhaps that we tend to put to the "back burner", to consider seriously at another, non-determined, time. Sadly, and often very tragically, we all know of someone who may have been called to God "before their time" and what then? Well, for them we pray and leave the rest in the hands of Almighty God. But for us who have been warned that our time may be nigh unexpectedly, perhaps God may be less lenient. As Christians and followers of God's word, we metaphorically are reminded to "stay dressed for action", "keep our lamps burning" and do whatever we can to remain true to God's words in what we say, think and

do. To be constantly concerned with our own limitations and "impending demise", is not something which our loving God would want us to fret over every minute of our day. Nonetheless, it is something for us to take heed of.

The Compline, the Night time prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours which Clergy and others recite daily, includes time for the "Examination of Conscience"; a reflection on the good and "not so good" words, thoughts and actions that have been taken for that day. The aim of this, with God's grace, is to put right any "shortfalls" in the following day. A regular "Examination of Conscience" would be good practice for all of us; we do just this in the Penitential Prayers at the beginning of every Mass.
