Luke 13:22-30 'People will come from east and west...'



Reflection: In this weekend's Gospel, we find Jesus on His way through towns and villages, teaching and journeying towards Jerusalem. He is asked by someone in the crowd: "Lord, will those who are saved be few?" A serious question and one which perhaps prompts another: "And will I be one of them?"

In response, Jesus avoids the question of numbers (such will be determined by God, the Father, alone) but He does provide an answer to the question of salvation. This is not the case of a simple formula: there is no "hidden" number. What we believe, and what Jesus promises, is that God's kingdom is open to all.

There are two conditions to this: Firstly, we need to pursue God's kingdom with every ounce of our being: "Strive to enter through the narrow door." In other words, true commitment to Christ is not an easy option, it

will not be "plain sailing." It requires from us total dedication, strengthened by God's grace and loving care. Secondly, even though we may do all that would seem required, keeping God's word and commands, we should never assume that our entry to the Kingdom is guaranteed. There is no "automatic" rite of passage. Often perhaps, as Catholic and Christian people, who may regularly attend Church and do all that is asked of us, we can too easily fall into the trap of judging others as "less worthy" than ourselves; we fall into the trap of recognizing the faults in others, whilst ignoring our own failings and weaknesses. This is not God's way, this is our own.

Jesus today calls out those who overlook others' virtues and reminds us that everyone shares the Pilgrim journey on Earth, no matter our status, religion, or background. God's kingdom is open to all, but salvation cannot be "earned" through own efforts; nor can it be "presumed" at the expense of others. It is only through Jesus, the Son of God, who is the "Way, Truth and Life", that entry can be secured.
