



Luke 18:9-14 'The Tax Collector went down to his house justified, rather than the Pharisee'



**Reflection:** In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus tells a simple story: "Two men went up into the Temple to pray...." The fact that one of these men is a Pharisee and the other is a Tax Collector would suggest through the eyes of the world, that the first was a man of virtue and good standing; the second a sinner who was despised for the job that he did. Now who would be the one to receive God's mercy? Not for the first time, Jesus turned the tables. Whilst the prayers of both men rise to heaven, only one found favour with God. Why was this the case? Well, put simply, God recognised what lay in each man's heart. The Pharisee thanked God but then continued in self-praise and adulation about his own merits whilst condemning the other for his wrongdoings. The Tax collector, on the other hand, stood far off, and with his head bowed down low said in all humility: "God be merciful to me a sinner." What

better prayer could there be, simple words but with a heartfelt confession.

Jesus reminds us that "everyone who exalts themselves will be humbled"; and that "everyone who humbles themselves will be exalted." God cannot hear us if we boast about ourselves and readily criticise others for what we see as their apparent misgivings. God can and will hear us if we humbly seek God's mercy and show mercy to others along the way.
