



Advent - a time for preparation: in this or any other year, we all need something to look forward to. The word Advent comes from the Latin: "ad ... venire", which means "to come to". Advent is that special time of the year when we wait for the celebration of Christmas, the Birth of the baby Jesus in the stable at Bethlehem, and His Second coming at the end of time. The Church also celebrates its new year this weekend, on the First Sunday of Advent and in this coming Liturgical Year A, we will focus on the Gospel of St Matthew and the weekday readings from Year II.

Advent is a great time and opportunity for us to re-focus our prayer life. In our busy lives, the real meaning of Christmas may become lost in the "commercial" world which is all around us. As we begin the Advent

season, let us do what we can to prepare well through prayer for the birth of Our Lord. Let us turn to God to ask for the grace to grow spiritually in God's loving care; a love that is patient and kind, gentle and ever present; a grace that brings peace and hope into all our lives. So let us stay awake and be ready, attuned to the glory and majesty that only God can bring.

"Lord Jesus, send your Holy Spirit upon our preparations for Christmas. We who have so much to do, seek quiet spaces to hear your voice each day. We, who are anxious over many things, look forward to your coming among us. We who are blessed in so many ways, long for the complete joy of your kingdom. We whose hearts are heavy, seek the joy of your presence. We are your people, walking in darkness, yet seeking your light."
