



Reflection: The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ. King of the Universe, commonly referred to as "the Feast of Christ the King" was instituted 100 years ago this year, by Pope Pius XI in 1925. The celebration marks the end of the Church's Liturgical Year. On this final Sunday of the Church's calendar, we are reminded that Jesus, the Son of God, who lived, died and rose again for our sake, is our King, the King of Heaven. Today is also "Youth Sunday", a Day of Prayer for Young People. So today we pray for all at Christ the King school, all who made their Confirmations recently, all who will be preparing for their First Holy Communion soon, all who join us in "Little Church" and/or on the Altar during Mass and for all our Altar Servers. Together, they represent the future for our Parish Churches. We

give thanks to God for them. And for all who are young or "young at heart" let us join in the prayer first uttered to Jesus on the Cross at Calvary by the repentant criminal: "Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom.'
