



Reflection: The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is a Feast Day which is celebrated by the entire church worldwide but not always on a Sunday as it is this weekend. The feast dates to the 4th Century shortly after Emperor Constantine's conversion to Christianity. Constine built the first great public church in Christian history, which in time became the first official cathedral of Rome, and the seat of the Pope, long before Saint Peter's which we know about now.

Today is also a day which reminds us of the importance of our own parish churches at Christ the King and Holy Cross in which we gather each week, in union with all other churches around the world. As Jesus reminds us in this weekend's Gospel, it is in the Body of Christ which we celebrate in Communion with one another, that lies our true home.

Remembrance Sunday: this weekend we pray for and commemorate all who have died in the two World wars and subsequent hostilities and whose contributions to peace and freedom should never be forgotten. "They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old: Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning, we will remember them." There will be a minute's silence at all Masses this weekend in honour of all who have lost their lives through conflicts.
