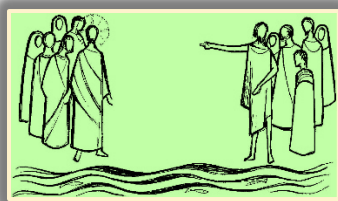

John 1:29-34 'Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.'



Reflection: We switch to the Gospel of St. John this weekend, the first in our new Season of "Ordinary Time", with the words first uttered by John the Baptist repeated at every Mass by the Priest as an invocation before Holy Communion: "Behold the Lamb of God" Jesus is the Son of God, The Lamb of God who takes away our sins and who through His great sacrifice gave us the chance to live again.

Last weekend we celebrated the Feast of the Baptism of our Lord. It was at the River Jordan that John baptized Jesus despite John's protestations to be "unworthy" to do so. Today, John puts that story straight by acknowledging Jesus as the true Light of the World and encourages his own supporters to "follow Him." That great act of humility and acceptance is an example for us all to do likewise.

When we acknowledge Jesus for who He is, we can do so through the supreme sacrifice of the Eucharist. And we can through prayers and the Word of God also.

Our Holy Father, Pope Leo's world-wide Prayer Intention for this month of January 2026 is: *For Prayer with The Word of God:* "Let us pray that praying with the Word of God be nourishment for our lives and a source of hope in our communities, helping us to build a more fraternal and missionary Church."
