Matthew: 4:12-23 'Follow me'



Reflection: I suspect that the first Apostles of Jesus didn't really know what they were letting themselves in for when they left their nets to follow Jesus. The same could be said for us. When Jesus began his Public Ministry, His opening words repeated in this weekend's Gospel were to "*Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.*"

Repentance basically means to "turn again" to "change" in terms of our mind and our actions to something different. The question is, what do we need to change or do differently to become more ardent followers of God?

Some people may suggest that "repentance" is a "once off born again" experience. Most Catholics would argue that it is, perhaps more realistically, an on-going through life experience. St Francis de Sales, Bishop of Geneva and Doctor of the Church, 1567 -1622, said it took him 20 years to overcome his recurring bad temper. Ongoing repentance for all of us is no bad thing.

The first Apostles of Jesus may not have fully understood their calling from the outset, in our case looking back we have the choice to follow the "Light of the World"; a light which darkness will never overshadow no matter how hard

it might try. "*The Lord is my light and my salvation*", with whom there is no fear, no matter how many times we may stumble and fall along the way. Our God is always there to pick us up again, provided we have a contrite heart.
