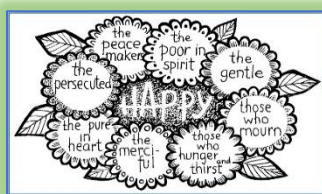

Matthew: 5:1-12a 'Blessed are the poor in spirit'



Reflection: The Sermon on the Mount is arguably the greatest homily ever given. Jesus spoke the following words of encouragement to a large crowd that had gathered to hear him speak. For many it is the most repeated and known message that Jesus ever gave:

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted. Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied. Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy. Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when men revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven." (Matthew 5:3-12)

If we want to know what the heart of God is like and how God comforts those who need it most, we need look no further than the words that Jesus spoke to that great crowd today. God's message on the mount teaches us how to become more like Him; how to be a person who is "pure in heart"; how to be kind, generous and truthful in what we do and say. This is the heart of Our God, that we share through the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Pope Leo XIV Prayer Intentions

Jan 2026 – *"Let us pray that praying with the Word of God may be nourishment for our lives and a source of hope in our communities, helping us build a more fraternal and missionary Church."*

Pope Leo has continued that prayer intention as we conclude the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (Jan 18th to Jan 25th).



Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Monday 2nd February is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This Feast occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus, and is also known as Candlemas day, marking the end of the Christmas season. With the presentation of the baby Jesus in the Temple by Mary and Joseph, and the prophecy of Simeon, events now point towards Easter. *Almighty ever-living God, just as your Only Begotten Son was presented on this*

day in the Temple in the substance of our flesh, so, by your grace, may we be presented to you, with minds made pure.
