

**Matthew: 5: 17 -37 'It was said to those of old; but I say to you'**

**Reflection:** We continue in this weekend's Gospel, Jesus' teaching on The Sermon on the Mount. This time, Jesus is talking directly to His Disciples, His chosen and closest followers, and is stressing to them that the Ten Commandments handed to Moses by God so many years, will remain the "blueprint" and guiding lines for entry into God's kingdom. However, what Jesus was also saying was that old habits and rigid ways of thinking were no longer good enough in themselves to enter God's kingdom. In other words, both in Jesus' time and in our own, a combination of "Old" and "New" ways of thinking, of believing, of acting are what is important.

If we wish to take seriously our invitation to "Follow Him", to make what may sometimes be small changes and modifications in what we do and are, then that time is now. We are invited to build from "old" to "new." We are invited to listen more attentively to the Word and Spirit of God, breathing afresh in our lives. We have the opportunity, as children of God, to understand more day by day the secrets of God's kingdom, which those perhaps who are more stubborn and less attuned to His Word may miss or choose to ignore.


**Friday Coffee (CTK):** please note that the next Friday coffee in the Parlour Room at Porch House, CTK will be on Friday 27th February. All are welcome.
